

TOWN OF NARRAGANSETT
CHAPTER 798

AN ORDINANCE IN AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 792

The Town Council of the Town of Narragansett hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 792 of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Narragansett, Rhode Island is hereby amended to include the following fee schedule, which shall be kept on file in the Office of the Town Clerk.

(a) Restoration fee as provided for in section 20-61 of the Code of Ordinances shall be as follows:

(b) The turn-on, turn-off fees as provided for in sections 20-61 and 20-157 of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Narragansett shall be ten dollars (\$10.00) for each turn-on and turn-off of any water service, unless as otherwise provided for under Section 20-61.

(c) Annual minimum charges shall be as follows:

(d) The fee for private fire connections as provided or in section 20-70 of the Code of Ordinances of the town of Narragansett shall be as follows:

(e) The fee for meter testing as provided for in section 20-160 of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Narragansett shall be twenty dollars (\$20.00) per meter test, unless the range of accuracy of the meter tested is found to be outside of the accuracy range set forth in section 20-160 of the Code of Ordinances.

(f) The charges for temporary service as provided for in section 20-162 of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Narragansett shall be as follows:

Where special pavement restoration techniques, including but not limited to infra-red patching, are required by either the Town pursuant to Chapter 17 or the State Department of Transportation, the actual cost of said pavement restoration including any permit fees shall be the responsibility of the customer and shall be added to the above schedule.

(h) The fee for temporary bulk water purchases as described with Sec. 20-162 (b) shall be as follows:

<i>Temporary Meter Fee</i>	<i>\$50.00</i>
<i>Commodity Charge</i>	<i>\$ 2.63 per 100 cubic feet</i>

All such bulk purchases shall be approved in advance by the Water Superintendent. Said approval shall depend on the availability of water and personnel, and the delivery of said bulk water shall be at a location specified by the Town. Bulk purchases shall be during normal working hours only.

(i) The annual fire service (public or private) hydrant charge shall be \$125.00 per hydrant.

(j) A charge of \$0.0259/100 gallons shall be assessed for all water sold pursuant to Rhode Island General Laws 46-15.3-5.

(k) A charge of \$1.10 per service connection shall be assessed for all service connections pursuant to Section 46-13-2.3 of the State of Rhode Island "rules and Regulations Pertaining to Public Water Systems".

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and all other ordinances or parts or ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.


