

**BOARD OF CANVASSERS**  
**March 10, 2022**

A meeting of the Narragansett Board of Canvassers and Registration was held on March 10, 2022 at 1:00 PM at the Narragansett Town Hall, 25 Fifth Avenue, Narragansett, RI.

Member Bourbonnais called the meeting to order at 1:02 PM.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

1.     Informational meeting with Election Data Services.

Clerk Craig introduced Kimball Brace and Ryan Taylor from Election Data Services.

Kim Brace explained the process of voting districts and how the lines changed due to the 2020 Census. Based on the census, Narragansett had a deficit of 1336 voters. District lines have moved so we now only have one Senate District. We have kept our Representatives in District 33 and 34.

As of this meeting the increase in the maximum number of voters per district from 3,000 to 3,500, has been approved by the House. The Senate will vote on it in a few days. Approval of 3,500 voters per district will decrease the number of polling places from 5 to 4.

Ryan Taylor presented us with the new precinct lines (working north to south). The new precincts will be:

- 2001 - St. Veronica Chapel
- 2002 - Mettatuxet Yacht Club
- 2003 - Narragansett Pier School
- 2004 - St. Mary's Star of the Sea Church

Motion by Member DeNuccio, seconded by Member Bourbonnais to approve the new lines as presented. Passed 3-0.

Having no further business, motion by Member Bourbonnais and seconded by Member Cote to adjourn. Passed 3-0.
