


Q1 Are you a Resident/Taxpayer of Narragansett or a Non-Resident?



Q2 Was the staff courteous?



Q3 Was the staff knowledgeable?





Q5 How clean is Narragansett Beach?



Q6 How clean were the restrooms?



Q7 How was your experience with the concession stand?



Q8 How frequently have you visited Narragansett Beach?







This past season I estimate that Narr. provided (presuming a fee of \$5 a car) free parking to non-residents of at least \$200k. That money could have been put in the Town's General Fund. I don't approve of Enterprise Funds which are under the control of a Dept. Director. The South Pavilion lockers should be available to Town residents only. No resident should have to wait for a locker. At the very least the policy of allowing a non-resident renter to buy an additional parking pass needs to end. Non-resident locker renters split the cost of a locker w/ another non-resident buy the add. parking pass and split the entrance passes. They both then use the lockers. And if you are crossing over 1A to get into the lot, that's even worse because you are stopped and holding up traffic because you can't enter the lot due to the multiple cars that are let in without passes asking where they can park. And the cars that don't care and cross anyway, block the road for oncoming traffic going the opposite way. WHY WHY can't the booth attendant ask the cars without passes to pull around to the other side of the booth so that the other attendant can help them with their parking questions. There are often 2 people in the booth. Wouldn't that make more sense than blocking traffic and holding up multiple vehicles. This is especially frustrating when it happens with 2,3,and 4 cars in a row. What's worse, I had this exact conversation with the manager one day when he happened to come by as we were pulling in.
