



Regional Shelter Transportation & Assistance Plan South Kingstown Office of Emergency Management

Due to significant power outages affecting South Kingstown, Narragansett, and North Kingstown, the regional shelter at Broad Rock Middle School is prepared to support residents who may need relocation due to loss of heat or unsafe conditions.

Who Should Call

Residents of South Kingstown, Narragansett and North Kingstown who:

- Are without power and heat
- Have medical or mobility concerns impacted by the outage
- Feel their home is no longer safe due to prolonged power loss
- Need information about shelter operations

Transportation Assistance

We are prepared to provide transportation to the regional shelter.

If you live in South Kingstown, Narragansett, or North Kingstown, we will arrange to come and pick you up and transport you safely to Broad Rock Middle School.

At this time, we are unable to provide transportation services to residents outside of these three communities.
